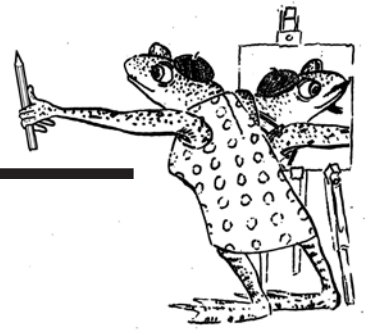

### Space wanted

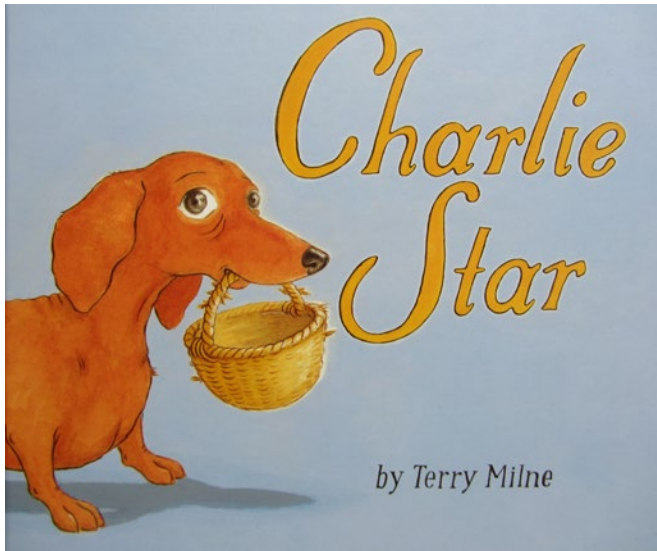

### Charlie Star

Local author Terry De Villiers has just published 'CHARLIE STAR', a children's picture book.

The story was inspired by a chance meeting with a charming dachshund called Charlie Star whose owner is local wood carver/artist, John Bye, of North Hinksey. In the book, Charlie is an anxious dachshund who worries



that something terrible might happen if he doesn't keep to his daily rituals. After he is called upon to help rescue a friend, and in the rush forgets his rituals, Charlie discovers that he doesn't have to be ruled by them and that change can have really positive outcomes. The issue of performing daily rituals to combat anxiety is dealt with in a light-hearted and reassuring way. Whether or not you are anxious, the story of Charlie Star is bound to capture your heart! ### A Christmas recipe

There are lots of keen cooks on the Island. This is a recipe for beigli, a Hungarian Christmas treat donated by Veronika Lukas's mum who lives in Hungary. Traditionally, beigli come in two flavours - with poppy seeds or walnut paste filling, although Veronika's mum makes a secret third roll with a cocoa filling for her grandchildren.

This recipe is for 2 rolls (one for each type of filling as below)

#### *The pastry*

500 g flour  
250 g margarine  
2 egg yolks  
60 g granulated sugar  
1 cup sour cream  
20 g fresh yeast

#### *The filling*

200 g ground poppy seeds mixed with caster sugar of the same amount  
or  
200 g ground walnuts mixed with caster sugar of the same amount

Stir a very small amount of milk and a bit of lemon juice into both fillings, and you can throw in some raisins, too, if you like. The fillings should be firm and not runny.

#### *Method*

1 Mix the flour, margarine, egg yolks, granulated sugar, cup of sour cream. Dissolve the yeast in a little warm milk, then add to the dough. Knead well together until the dough

is moist. Place in a bowl and set aside covered with a damp cloth for an hour.

2 Halve the dough and roll both halves into rectangles around half an inch thick.

3 Fill the rolls with the fillings (one filling for one roll) but be careful not to put too much in, and also leave a bit of dough at the edges. Roll the dough up to form a log. Brush the top with egg yolk. Set aside again a little.

4 Make holes in the top with a fork. Bake the logs in the oven at 180°C until golden brown, about 35-40 minutes.
